I understand that I am required to:

- (a) Behave in a responsible manner whilst participating in any UNSW Global activity, including travelling to and from the activity site
Read and follow any notices, instructions and schedules relating to the activity, attend any briefing sessions
- (b) and return any forms to the staff member in charge
- (c) Seek further instructions from a Supervisor if I am unsure of something I am required to do
- (d) Not operate equipment that I am unfamiliar with
- (e) Comply with instructions, directions, and safety procedures issued by the Supervisor
- (f) Take action to avoid, eliminate or minimise risks
- (g) Avoid, as far as possible, exposure to venomous animals and plants likely to cause allergic reactions (e.g. wear appropriate clothing such as long sleeves and trousers where there is a risk of abrasion, being scratched from low-lying shrubbery, snake or insect bites apply insect repellent, carry appropriate treatment for hay fever and other allergic reactions)
- (h) Ensure that I have adequate protection from the weather. This may include hat, sunglasses, and sun screen for UV protection, and adequate clothing
- (i) Carry sufficient drink and any medical necessities (such as an inhaler if asthmatic)
- (j) Use safe practice when crossing roads e.g. cross carefully at pedestrian crossings or at traffic lights
- (k) Report any unsafe conditions or hazards to the Supervisor
- (l) Not wilfully place at risk the health and safety of any person on the trip or any member of the public by my actions or omissions
- (m) Seek information or advice regarding hazards and procedures where necessary before carrying out activities that are new or unfamiliar
- (o) Inform the Activity Supervisor of any medical conditions or prescription drugs etc. that may impact on my ability to take part in any activities that I intend to participate in. The attached health report in Section 2 can be used for this purpose
- (p) Manage existing medical conditions in accordance with advice from my own medical practitioner
- (q) Provide a current email contact address that is regularly checked and is active to receive emails. Reading and following any email instructions regarding the trip
